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Dear Parent/Guardian of a Future 6th Grader,

Although your child is only half way through the 5th grade, we want to inform you of the requirements for entry into 6th grade, as many people visit their health care providers throughout the school year. For entry to 6th grade, no student may attend school until the health requirements are met. **Required medical forms can be completed and returned to the Daniel Wright school nurse now; you do not need to wait until registration for the 2018-2019 school year.**

Physical Examination: Physical examinations are required of all students completed within one year prior to entrance into 6th grade. This physical exam must be recorded on the *State of Illinois Certificate Of Child Health Examination Form*. **Remember to check and sign the "Health History" portion for parent completion.** It is not necessary to submit an additional SPORTS PHYSICAL form for Interscholastic Sports participation, as this exam will meet the requirements for participation. It will expire 395 days from the date of the physical exam.

Dental Examination: Dental examinations are required of all students in 6th grade. The examination must be performed by a licensed dentist, completed on the *Dental Examination Record Form*, and be on file in the school health office. To meet 2018-2019 school year requirements, the dental examinations must be completed between November 15, 2017 and May 15, 2019.

Immunizations: Immunizations must be up-to-date, recorded on the *State of Illinois Certificate Of Child Health Examination Form*, and administered as recommended by the Illinois Dept. of Public Health per State of IL mandates. Students must show evidence of immunity against Polio, Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Hepatitis B, Haemophilus Influenza Type B, Varicella and Meningitis.

If needed, please contact your child's doctor or clinic to make an appointment and to obtain your child's health/vaccination records and send in documentation to the **Daniel Wright health office**. If you have questions or need assistance, contact Kelly Brunning, RN at (847) 295-1560.
